

Things to know ahead of time:

- Although it's not absolutely necessary, I'd suggest that you use earbuds (rather than your computers' speakers) to avoid feedback issues.
- Questions during the seminar are definitely encouraged!

- However, by checking your system as suggested below ahead of time, and familiarizing yourself with the interface beforehand, it should eliminate problems.

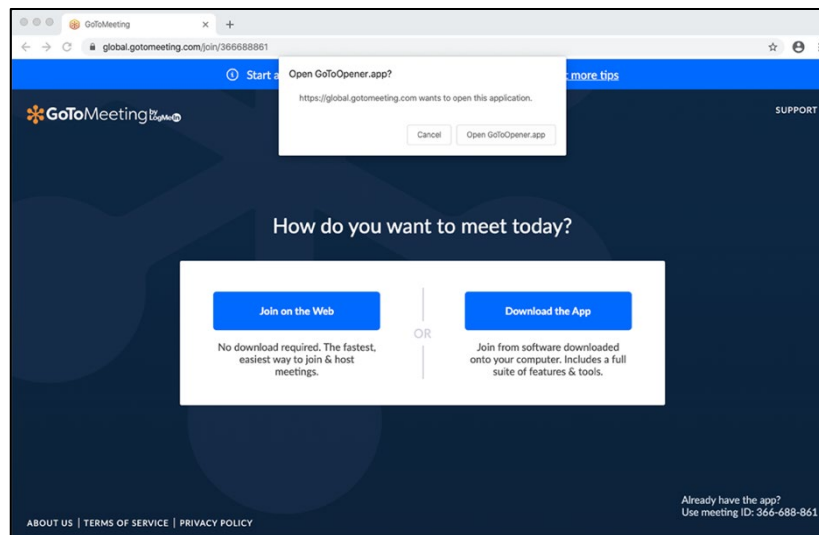

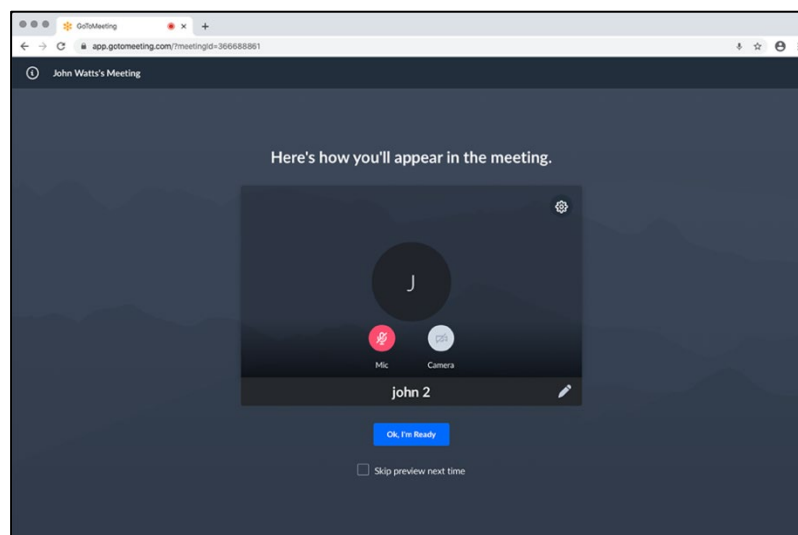

Specific Steps: (To see the screen grabs in more detail, simply enlarge the PDF)

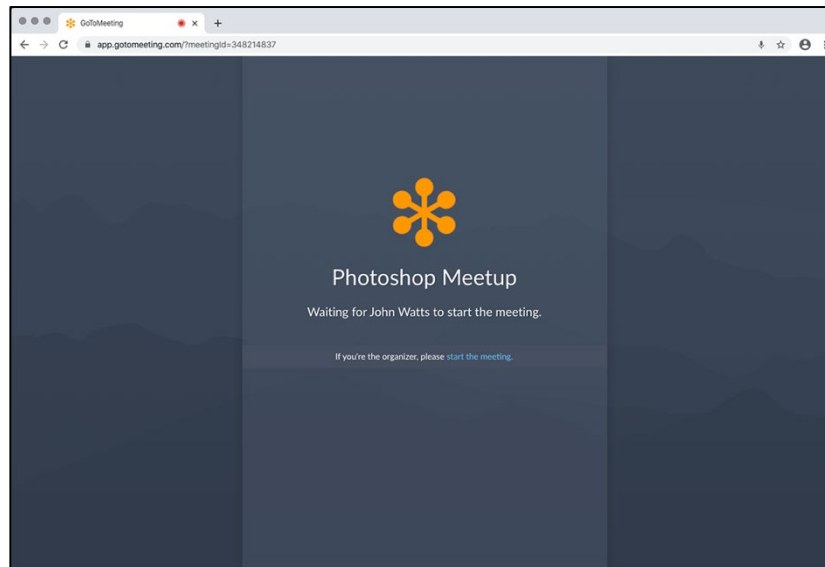
- 1) Open a Browser.
- 2) In your Browser, use the GoToMeeting link provided ahead of time.
- 3) If prompted, click on *“Open GoToOpener.app”* & *“Join on the Web”*



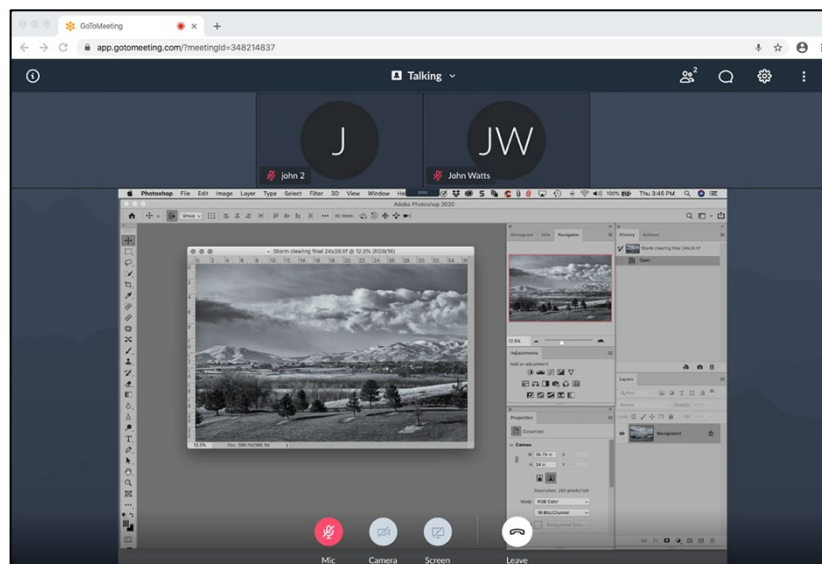
- 4) As you won't be sharing your webcam, just click on *“OK, I'm Ready”*, unless you want to change your screen name first (click on the “pencil” icon)



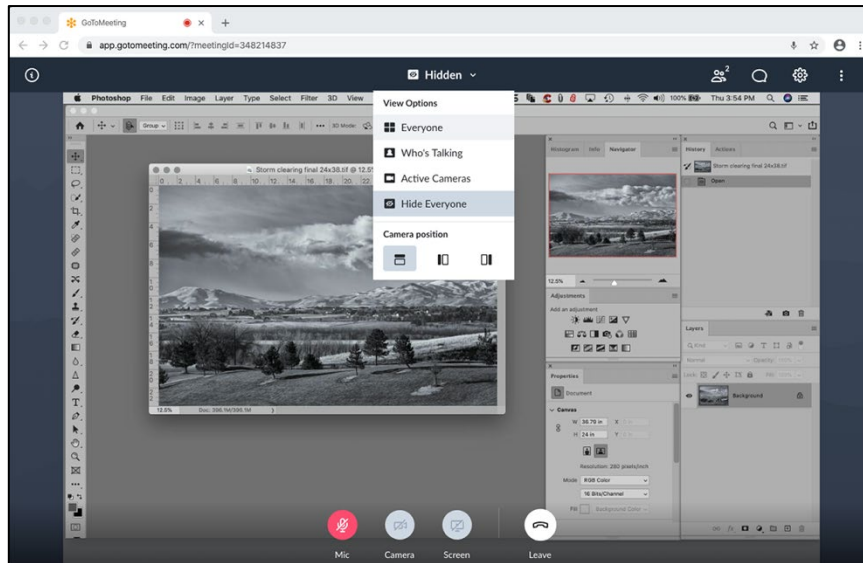
5) If the meeting hasn't started yet, you'll see a screen similar to this:



6) When the Meetup starts (I'll be online at least 10 minutes before the start time), the main screen opens, showing my desktop:



- 7) To make the Webcam boxes disappear (and make the viewing area larger), choose “Hide Everyone” from the drop-down menu at top-center.



- 8) To talk using “audio”, click in the red “Mic” button until it turns green.
